Code of Ethics

PREAMBLE:

Innovation and creativity are the most important aspects of the academic activities pertaining to teaching-learning. However, the process of teaching-learning requires maintaining integrity and following a code of ethics.

OBJECTIVES:

- To create awareness regarding responsibility, ethics, and integrity in matters related to teaching-learning in the areas of research, project work, assignment etc.
- To prevent academic misconduct and malpractice, specifically avoiding plagiarism in academic affairs by students, faculty as well as any employee of the institution.

WHAT IS CONSIDERED AS PLAGIARISM?

Plagiarism is generally understood as an academic malpractice wherein author/s try to steal and pass off the ideas or words of another author/s as his/her own without acknowledging the credit of the original author/s. Plagiarism can be either intentional where the author/s deliberately present/s another person's work as one's own, or unintentional where the author/s carelessly commit/s mistake of passing the work of somebody else as his/her own.

POLICY TO DEAL WITH PLAGIARISM

The institute maintains its zero tolerance policy to deal with the matters to related to plagiarism. It is the sole responsibility of the concerned students, faculty, and staffs of the institute to refrain from using any unfair means. They are suggested to check the amount of plagiarism using various softwares/tools available in the market. They are further advised to use paraphrasing, and referencing to avoid plagiarism. By submitting any documents such as thesis, dissertation, assignment, or any

type of publications, the concerned students, faculty should ensure that those are free of plagiarism. If found otherwise, the institute is liable to take any punishable measures as prescribed by UGC.
